All local artists and HAS members are invited to enter a visual artwork or artworks that feature "Community Milestones." The scope is broad: consider buildings, objects, special events, natural heritage, Aboriginal tradition, creative use of old buildings, inventions. All forms of visual arts including all painting mediums, sculpture, glass, ceramic and photography are eligible for entry. Please note we have limited capability to display multimedia works and artists are invited to contact us before making their submission.

Entries close on Friday 12 April, 2013 and we look forward to promoting your work as part of this exhibition.

EXHIBITION DETAILS

DELIVERY & COLLECTION OF ART WORKS - is between 4 - 6 pm Sunday 21 April 2013. Collection is strictly between 4 - 6 pm on Sunday 5 May 2013.

ENTRIES - The maximum number of works per entrant is 2, subject to space considerations. Artwork may be in any medium, including sculptures. Sculptors, glass or ceramic artists are encouraged to supply appropriate plinths for the display of their works.

OFFICIAL OPENING - 7.00pm Friday 26 April 2013 - Hornsby Art Society warmly invites you, your family and friends to our Opening Night. **Please bring a plate of food to share**, and drinks will be provided.

PRESENTATION - Works must be properly mounted or framed and hung by D rings or staples, with strong cord. No cup hooks, screw eyes or other protruding metal or wire. No wet paintings will be accepted. Works on stretched canvases need not be framed, but must be presented in a neat, professional manner, with finished edges & no staples visible.

IDENTIFICATION - Each Entry must be labelled clearly with your name, telephone number, title, and price or NFS on back of work.

LIMITATIONS TO ARTWORK SIZE - Hanging works are not to exceed 1m x 1.5m, including framing. Weight of artworks is not to exceed 10 kg.

SELECTION OF WORKS - Works will be hung by the HAS Hanging Team, subject to adherence to the conditions outlined.

ENTRY FEE & COMMISSION - Entry Fee is \$15 per work (\$10 for HAS members) and all sales will be managed by HAS with a 25% commission on all sales retained by HAS.
