How to Enter the Christmas Art Sale

ART SALE ENTRIES

All local artists are invited to enter – the maximum number of works per entrant is ten, subject to space considerations. All artworks must be the original work of the entrant and signed by the artist. Artwork may be in any medium, including sculptures. In addition to artworks, we accept original craft items such as cards, jewellery, textiles and other small suitable gifts items provided they are appropriately presented and packaged. All sellers of such items are also encouraged to participate in the Makers Market.

Artists are encouraged to enter works suitably priced for Christmas gift-giving and with a suggested maximum price of \$500. Works marked 'not for sale' are ineligible for entry.

EXHIBITION DETAILS, ENTRY FEE & COMMISSION

The Art Sale will be held from Tuesday 4 – Sunday 9 December and open 10am – 4pm daily. Artists pay \$20 (HAS members) and \$30 (non HAS members) to enter up to ten works & all Entry Fees are non-refundable. Sales will be managed by HAS with a 25% commission on all exhibition sales retained by HAS. As a condition of entry, participating artists must fulfil one three hour shift on the Exhibition Roster.

SELECTION OF WORKS

Works will be hung or displayed by the HAS Hanging Team, subject to adherence to the conditions outlined.

Because of the large quantity of works offered for sale, not all artworks can be hung. Artworks will be arranged appropriately on tables or stacked against walls and re-arranged as needed throughout the Exhibition. As artworks are sold on a 'cash and carry' basis, artworks will be rearranged continually throughout the period of the exhibition and sale.

ARTISTS ENTER AT THEIR OWN RISK

Hornsby Art Society take all reasonable care in handling and dealing with artworks submitted.

The organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage incurred to any of the artworks entered.

How to Enter the Maker's Market

The Maker's Market will be held on Sunday 9 December from 10am – 4pm. Tables will be provided to sellers throughout the rooms of the homestead and within Beatrice Taylor Hall, and sellers **must** staff their table throughout the day. Shared or group tables are most welcome.

All forms of art and craft suitable for Christmas giving is encouraged. Examples are small artworks, unframed works, jewellery, ceramics, paper craft, Christmas cakes or puddings, textiles, knitted/crocheted items, candles, soaps or oils, table decorations, etc

Table bookings will be on a first come, first served basis, and HAS reserves the right to refuse applications based upon duplication of works to be sold.

MAKER'S MARKET – ENTRY FEE & COMMISSION

Maker's Market Day table sellers pay \$20 (HAS Members) or \$30 (non HAS Members) for a table and 10% of their day's sales to HAS by way of commission. HAS can also assist with credit card sales where needed. Fill in the attached Makers' Market Entry Form to secure your place.

PRESENTATION OF WORKS

FRAMED WORKS - All framed artworks must be properly mounted or framed and hung by D rings. No cup hooks, screw eyes or protruding metal or wire. No wet paintings will be accepted. Works on stretched canvases need not be framed, but must be presented in a neat, professional manner, with finished edges & no staples visible.

UNFRAMED WORKS - All unframed works must be suitably packaged in either plastic artist sleeves or archive quality clear plastic, ready for sale. Works submitted in cling wrap, cellophane or other non-professional packaging will not be accepted. Unpackaged works will not be accepted.

HAS reserves the right to reject artworks or craft items that are deemed unsuitably presented for sale.

Hanging works are not to exceed 1m x 1.5m, including framing. Weight of artworks is not to exceed 10 kg.

LABELLING OF WORKS - Each Entry **must** be labelled clearly with your name, telephone number, title, and the price on the back of work.

EVENT PROMOTION

PROMOTING YOUR WORKS – We promote the HAS Christmas Art Sale and Maker's Market through websites, HAS and other Facebook sites, banners and local newspapers. Flyers will be circulated through Wallarobba and through local libraries.

All participating artists will be provided with e-flyers and images for Facebook that they can use to promote the event through their own social media networks. Artists are particularly encouraged to promote the Art Sale and Maker's Market to their own friends, families and artistic networks.

DIGITAL PHOTOS OF ENTRIES - Artists are encouraged to provide images of their works, so these can be used for promotion via our website, Facebook and on a variety of advertising materials.

HAS reserves the right to reproduce images of all artworks entered in the Art Sale or the Maker's Market for any catalogue, publicity, advertising or archival purposes in any manner connected with the exhibition or our HAS sponsors, including future books that may be produced by HAS relating to our organisation or our exhibitions.
